District Lodge 19 will conduct a rerun election at Local Lodge 1299 for the following office, which will be a 4-year term, commencing on October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2027.

- **1-President/Directing General Chairman**

Only members in good standing of LL 1299 will be permitted to vote in person, or if eligible, by mail-in ballot. The voting location will be open on **Wednesday November 1, 2023, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** at the address listed below.

To assist in verifying your eligibility to vote in this election, **please bring this letter with you to your Local Lodge 1299 election, along with a photo ID.**

### **ELECTION NOTICE**

Local Lodge 1299 will conduct the Rerun District Lodge 19 Officer election for **1-President/ Directing General Chairman** on Wednesday November 1, 2023, from 6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. (see election location above). In order to have their ballot counted, a member must be in good standing of IAM District Lodge 19. Anyone identified on the Local Lodge 1299 voter eligibility list is eligible to vote. Anyone who does not appear on the Local Lodge 1299 voter eligibility list, will be instructed to vote a challenged ballot. Members voting at the Local Lodge 1299 polling site must present a valid photo ID, such as a state driver's license, company ID, military ID, passport, etc.

All eligible members who arrive at the polls between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. will be permitted to cast their ballot. Polls will remain open for this purpose if you're standing in line at poll closing time.

The Candidate who receives the highest number of total District Lodge 19 votes for this race, will win the Election.

## **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

**Members who:** (1) reside more than twenty-five (25) miles from the designated balloting place; or (2) are confined because illness or injury; or (3) are on leave qualifying under Federal, State or Territorial family leave laws; or (4) are working members on vacation or retirees more than 25 miles away from their residence on election day; or (5) are on official IAM business approved by LL, DL or GL; or (6) are on employer travel assignment; (7) are on military leave, may participate in the vote in the election by absentee ballot, upon request.

Eligible members wishing to receive an absentee ballot must complete the enclosed Absentee Ballot Request Form, or a letter including the same information, and mail it as soon as possible but not later than 10 days before the vote date set forth in this notice.

All Absentee Ballot Request must be made singly, in writing by the requesting member and delivered by United States Postal Service mail to the District Lodge 19 Secretary-Treasurer at: IAM District Lodge 19 Secretary-Treasurer, Richard D. Nadeau, Jr, 7010 Broadway, Suite 203 Denver, CO 80221. Only 1-member request per envelope.

District Lodge 19 will confirm your eligibility to vote by absentee ballot and mail you a ballot, with instructions, approximately 2 days after receipt of your request, or from receipt of printed ballots, whichever is later. Members found not eligible to vote by absentee ballot will be sent notification within 2 days after receipt of the request. If you do not receive a response to your request for an absentee ballot, **call IAM District Lodge 19 at (303) 243-3138**.

Absentee Election Ballots for the November 1, 2023 election must be received, via United States Postal Service, in the designated District Lodge 19 Election P.O. Box, no later than 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time on Wednesday November 1, 2023, at the address on the absentee ballot return envelope, which will be provided. Absentee ballots received after the date and time set forth above will not be counted.

Protests concerning the conduct of this election must be made in writing to the International President within 30 days of the final tally of ballots. (IAM Official Circular No. 869 LMRDA (Landrum-Griffin Election and Other Requirements))


## **IMPORTANT**
